

Gale is a Biology teacher at a local school, St Steven's. She's come to Monastery Road on this manic Monday with a serious complaint to make!

Annie Sprinkles:

Annie is Derek's ex-girlfriend. She's pleasant and kind, but she's also naive and doesn't seem to realise that her relationship with Derek is over.

Miracle LeSash:

Miracle is a club singer who's been touring the country, largely unsuccessfully, for over 20 years. She loves performing but has found her own career much less successful than 'Wha-Hey's!!'. She too enters the studios with a score to settle. She won't take no for an answer!




