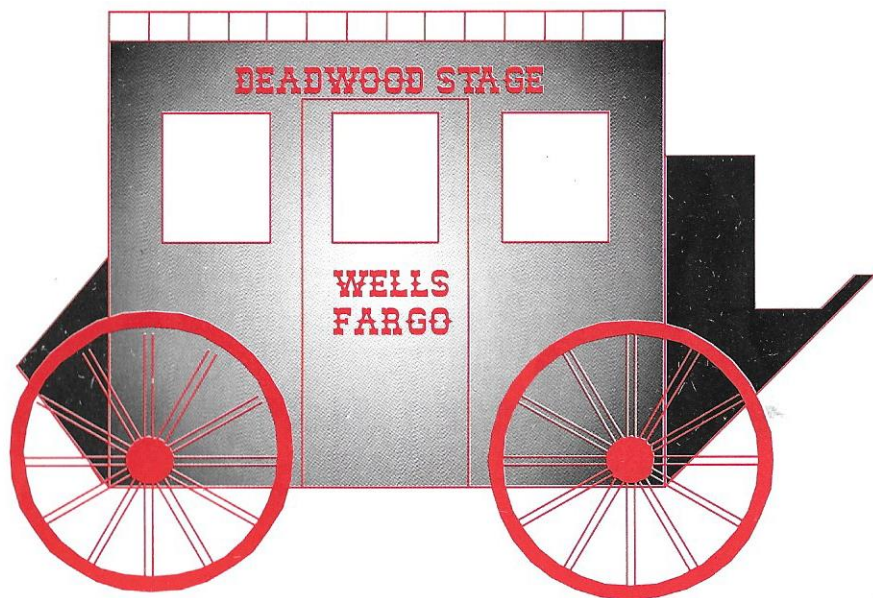

CALAMITY JANE



Martha Jane Canary was born in Princeton, Missouri 1st May 1852 She was orphaned and by 1867 began roaming the mining districts of the West. She was a very familiar sight in Deadwood City, Dakota Territory. In 1891 she married Clinton Burke but he soon deserted her. She toured in Wild West shows and claimed to have been a Pony Express rider and a scout for General Custer. The origin of her nickname, like much about her legendary life, is uncertain. It has been suggested "Calamity" may have reflected the bad luck she had, the fate of her enemies - because of her skill with a pistol, her readiness to help in times of trouble or even the fate that would befall any man who tried to tame her.

Calamity Jane and Wild Bill Hickock were never romantically involved but when she died, in 1903, in Terry, South Dakota she was buried next to him in Mount Moriah cemetery in Deadwood.
